Entry Qualification requirements

The selection procedure adopted by SLITHM conforms to the minimal entry qualifications adopted by the University Grants Commission's eligibility requirements for undergraduate study programmes. Below are a few criteria's that have to be met;

✓ Minimum "Simple pass" (S) is a must for all three approved subjects in one sitting or within a maximum of three attempts. A minimum mark of 30% for the General knowledge paper is a must. Candidates who have not obtained 30% for the General knowledge paper are not eligible to apply for this course.

- ✓ If the candidate has obtained a minimum of 30% for the General knowledge paper in within a maximum of THREE attempts, is eligible to apply.
- ✓ Any other qualification of comparable standing (recognized by UGC of Sri Lanka) can be considered.
